

# MULTIBANK PARTNERS



The Brick Multibank redistributes surplus and donated goods to people on low incomes who are struggling to cover the costs of everyday essentials. These items range from bedding and cleaning products to clothes and toiletries.


All items are distributed free of charge through a growing network of over **400 referral partners** who are placed at the epicentre of their local community. Our partners include schools, social care professionals, charities and community groups who have helped the project distribute **1.2 million items and supported over 120,000 families across the North-West** in less than two years.

Our stock lists are updated each week, depending on deliveries and stock fluctuations. We offer our partners both a click and collect or delivery service of vital non-food items to be distributed with local communities and into the hands of families who need them. This gives us great confidence that the goods provide a platform upon which families can build for the future and organisations can more effectively engage in their support.



A Social Return on Investment study was published in 2024 which found the following impact on families supported through this project:

- 43% said the support helped them avoid a crisis situation
- 86% said it reduced their stress and anxiety
- 81% said it improved their confidence and wellbeing
- 98% increased their financial wellbeing
- 71% improved their outlook on life
- 73% led to better family relationships
